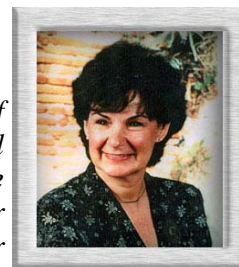

Susan's Corner



I just filmed a new series that should be out shortly and I hope you all will call your television stations to request that it be on the air this fall. We will do another new series in October that will be following in the spring. Each series will have a book with one

featuring landscapes, The Joy of Painting Landscapes, and the other featuring florals, Enjoy Painting Fresh Florals. We are working to get the books ready for fall release.

Weber has made for me, and shortly available for you, what I call The Big Brush. I use The Big Brush on the shows along with my other brushes. This brush is 2 inches wide and perfect for doing backgrounds, clouds and foliage in acrylics and it can be used in larger watercolors as well. I needed The Big Brush to do some of the larger canvas painting and it even makes some of the smaller paintings easier to create. Those of you who oil paint you will love this brush as well.

As you read this, you should find there is now available a 3 hour DVD - Trees & Leaves - which has been broken down with a wonderful menu making it easy to go to your selections. I feel sure you will be delighted with the information on the do and do not tips, showing how easy it is to paint trees and leaves easily using the correct brushes and techniques.

There is just one more workshop scheduled this fall in August in Portland. However, I will be teaching at the Seattle mini convention and several classes at the New England Traditions convention in Providence, Rhode Island this fall. I hope you will be able to attend one of those class events.

Having just taught several workshops here, there were several students who thought using a light weight paper would work until they tried the 185 lb. Scheewe paper. Then they quickly understood what a great difference it made in their ease to lift pigment when desired and not tearing.

Some also tried using a weaker pigment but soon found their paint was not making the beautiful rich tones in the landscapes. Then with a change to my Scheewe paints, they realized just how important using good quality paints made in their ability to create lovely work.

With fall just around the corner get a head start on painting some seasonal paintings. Gift tags, bookmarks and greeting cards are always great to practice leaves, trees and small landscapes. Use the acrylics to paint table runners with a fall scene of pumpkins with accent edges of napkins. You can paint on the 185lb acrylic/watercolor paper and have it laminated for personalized placemats. Gourds are about ready and you can paint those with the Scheewe acrylics to decorate your home. Make a memory book page with the children as they paint their own Halloween pumpkins using watercolors and allow them to paint the page where the photos are to be placed.
