The set contains seven tubes of Artist Quality Prima® Acrylic Colors, Titanium White, Grisaille Glowing White, Grisaille Light, Gray, Grisaille Dark, Iridescent White, Ivory Black plus sample drawing, Gray tone Value painting, glazed color painting, and clear instructions by Bernadette Kunko.

The Prima Acrylic Gray Tone Value Set is ideal for creating underpaintings, Grisaille Technique paintings, and to be added to tube paints to lower the chroma, thus toning down the color.

Underpainting is a foundation coat of color to make the painting process easier. It helps the artist create the preliminary values for still life, landscape, portrait and any other paintings. The Gray Tone Value painting can be used as a finished painting. It will look similar to a black and white photograph. The painting maybe glazed with one or more layers of transparent color. The addition of a medium such as Weber Oil Transparentizing Medium or Weber Oil Painting Medium will transparentize the oil colors and add a beautiful glaze over the Gray Tone Value painting. We recommend Weber Prima Oil Color Set, Item 2290 for the glazing technique.
